The role of the Gambling Education & Prevention Lead is to oversee Ara's new and existing educational programmes designed to raise awareness of gambling related harm and to support Ara's early intervention and prevention service. The successful candidate will provide line management to the Youth Education and Prevention Team, and lead on delivering a service aimed at promoting greater understanding of gambling harms amongst young people across Wales & the South West of England.

Some of the key tasks for this role include to:

- Manage a team of Education & Prevention workers targeting young people to raise awareness of gambling related harm across Wales & the South West, supporting Ara's early intervention and prevention offer.
- Providing leadership and a high level of operational competency to ensure team performance and project objectives are achieved.
- Work with Regional Managers to ensure all of Ara's educational offers are to the highest standard, meeting with collaborative partners and commissioners to evaluate and review performance.
